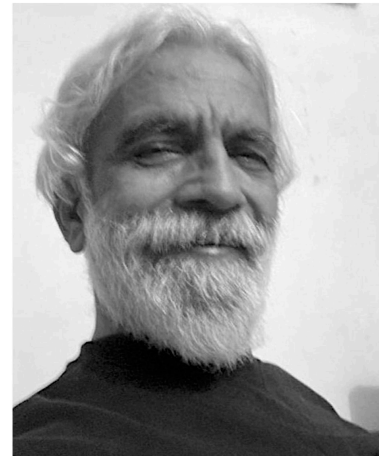




Jogi Panghaal

He continues to research and teach at several design schools including at NID in India. He has taught at institutions like Les Ateliers in Paris and Gerrit Rietveld Academie in Amsterdam among other institutions.
